Canada has several ecological regions. We will only look at the following: (see the map).

- the Cordilleras
- the interior plains
- the Canadian Shield
- the Great Lakes/St. Lawrence lowlands
- the Arctic lowlands
- the Appalachian/Atlantic region

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

Climate: The weather changes less between seasons than in the rest of Canada. The winters are never very cold and summers are never very hot. But it rains a lot (over 2000 mm of rain each year).
